

News from the Rabbi Search Committee July 2011

The Rabbi Search Committee (RSC) has been meeting weekly for the past month and a half. We have completed our application to the Central Conference of American Rabbis (CCAR). The application has been posted on the CCAR website where rabbis can view it and inquire about our position through the offices of the CCAR. Over the summer, we will begin to receive and review resumes from rabbinic candidates. Based on the experience of the CCAR, we will get the biggest surge of contacts from candidates just after the High Holy Days in the fall. In the meantime, the RSC is working on preparing our interview and evaluation strategies.

Each month, the RSC will write updates in the Shofar and on the TBT website at www.templebethtikvahct.org to keep you informed about our progress.
