The lighting of the Shabbat candles welcomes the beauty of Shabbat into our homes. The traditional lighting of candles takes place 18 minutes before sunset. The times listed for Erev (the evening) of Shabbat reflect that traditional time. In our homes, whether we light the candles at the time prior to sunset or whenever we can gather for our Shabbat dinner, the kindling of the Shabbat lights offers a message of joy and hope.

In January, traditional candle lighting times for the Connecticut Shoreline are: 1/6 - 4:17 pm; 1/13 - 4:25 pm; 1/20 - 4:33 pm; 1/27 - 4:41 pm.
